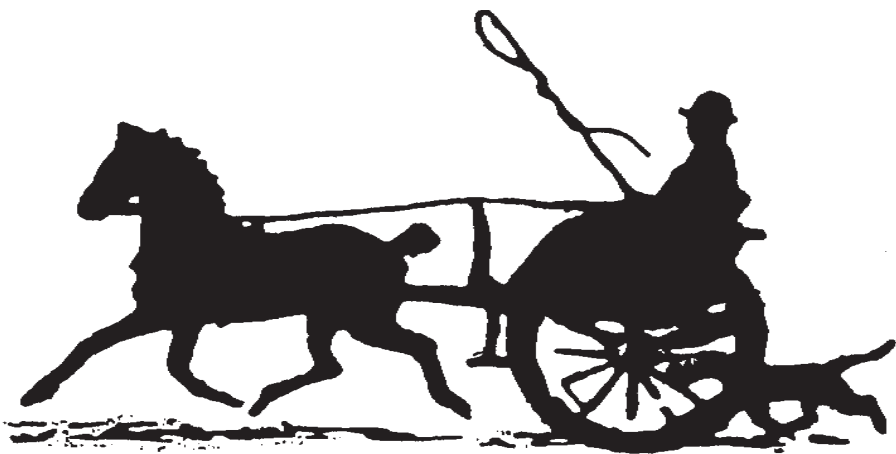

WELSH COBS IN HAND

- Class 1** Welsh Pony (*cob type*) any age up to 13.2 hands Section 'C' to be shown in hand.
Class 2 Welsh Cob, any age over 13.2 hands Section 'D' to be shown in hand.
(if there are insufficient entries the above classes will be amalgamated or cancelled)

HACKNEY IN HAND

- Class 3** Hackney Horse over 14 hands (*in hand*)
Class 4 Hackney Pony under 14 hands (*in hand*)
Class 5 Novice Driving Class (Horse) driven to gig, trap, event vehicle or exercise vehicle
Class 6 Exercise Vehicle up to 13.2 hands
Class 7 Exercise Vehicle over 13.2 hands
Qualifier - Single Turnout driven to a TWO wheeled Exercise Vehicle
Qualifier - Single Turnout driven to a FOUR wheeled Exercise Vehicle
Qualifier - Pair or Tandem driven to a four wheeled exercise vehicle
* - OPEN TO PLEASURE AND EXERCISE VEHICLES WITH TRADITIONAL TYPE OR PNEUMATIC WHEELS
- Class 8** Single Non Hackney Type Ponies (excluding Reg. Welsh) 13.2 hands and under to a suitable traditional type vehicle. QUALIFIER.
- Class 9** Single Non Hackney Type (Excluding reg. Welsh) over 13.2 hands driven to a suitable traditional type vehicle Class. QUALIFIER.
- Class 9a** Single Pure Bred - Reg. Welsh Cob section D driven to a suitable traditional type vehicle. QUALIFIER Section D.
- Class 10** Single Pure Bred Reg. Welsh Pony to a traditional type vehicle, QUALIFIER A, B & QUALIFIER C.
- Class 10a** Open Showmans Class to show your charisma with manners - any type of vehicle
- Class 11** Country Turnouts - any height - for example Jaunting Car, Governess Cart, Dog Cart, Ralli Car. QUALIFIER - Single Country Turnout
- Class 12** Single Hackney Type - any height to a suitable traditional type vehicle
- Class 13** Shetland Pony Driving - any vehicle.
- Class 13a** Miniature Horse Driving to a suitable vehicle.

HACKNEY DRIVING

- Class 14** Hackney Horse over 14 hands (*driving*) to a show Wagon (*single harness driven to by lady/gent*)
Class 15 Hackney Ponies under 14 hands (*driving*) to a show Wagon (*single harness driven by lady/gent*)
Class 16 Disabled Drivers - Single Ponies or Donkeys
Class 17 Concours D'Elegance and Show Drive (No entry fee) must enter in a class.
Class 18 Junior Whip - should not be over 18 years (*must be accompanied by an adult*). *Judged on ability of Junior Whip.*
QUALIFIER - Single Traditional Type Vehicle 10-14 years. QUALIFIER - Single Traditional Type Vehicle 15-17 years. QUALIFIER - Single Turnout to an Exercise Vehicle 10-14 years. Single Turnout to an Exercise Vehicle 15-17 years.
- Class 19** Lady Whip (*Judged on ability of Lady Whip*)
Class 20 Light Trade and Coachman Driven Class. Qualifier 2 wheel light trade. Qualifier 4 wheeled light trade
Class 21 Multiple Class (Pairs & Tandems - Open. Any height.)
Class 22 Open Class - under 12 hands driven to a suitable vehicle.
